- To lobby for uniform standards and certified training to enhance service delivery and professional competence of paralegals.

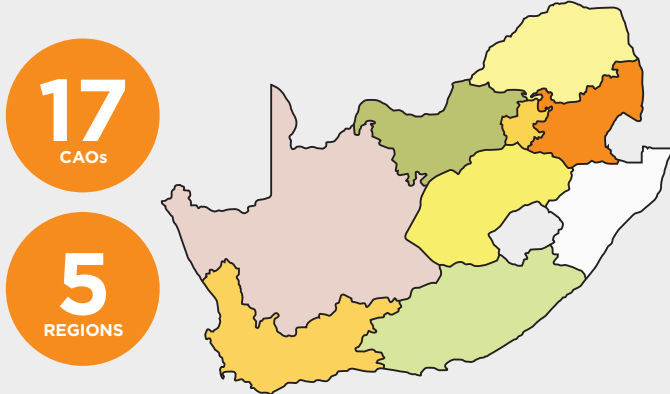
Structure Operation
